These expenses are not paid directly by Fund shareholders. Instead, Fund shareholders bear these expenses indirectly because they reduce Fund performance. Because "Acquired fund fees and expenses" are included in the chart, the Fund's operating expenses here will not correlate with the expenses included in the Financial highlights in the Prospectus and the Fund's Form N-CSR. Under the Fund's expense reimbursement arrangements, the Fund's investment adviser, Teachers Advisors, LLC ("Advisors"), has contractually agreed to reimburse the Fund for any Total annual Fund operating expenses (excluding interest, taxes, brokerage commissions or other transactional expenses, Acquired fund fees and expenses, extraordinary expenses and any expenses originally attributable to Class W shares of the Underlying Funds of the Trust that were incurred directly by the Fund) that exceed 0.018% of average daily net assets for Class R6 shares of the Fund. These expense reimbursement arrangements will continue through at least September 30, 2026, unless changed with approval of the Board of Trustees. Advisors has contractually agreed to waive 0.082% of the Fund's Management fee. This waiver will remain in effect through at least September 30, 2026, unless changed with the approval of the Board of Trustees.

(12)JPMorgan Mid Cap Growth Fund - Class R6 Shares: The Fund's adviser and/or its affiliates have contractually agreed to waive fees and/or reimburse expenses to the extent Total Annual Fund Operating Expenses (excluding acquired fund fees and expenses other than certain money market fund fees as described below, dividend and interest expenses related to short sales, interest, taxes, expenses related to litigation and potential litigation, expenses related to trustee elections, and extraordinary expenses) exceed 0.65% of the average daily net assets of Class R6 Shares. The Fund may invest in one or more money market funds advised by the adviser or its affiliates (affiliated money market funds). The Fund's adviser, shareholder servicing agent and/or administrator have contractually agreed to waive fees and/or reimburse expenses in an amount sufficient to offset the respective net fees each collects from the affiliated money market funds on the Fund's investment in such money market funds. These waivers are in effect through 10/31/26, at which time it will be determined whether such waivers will be renewed or revised. To the extent that the Fund engages in securities lending, affiliated money market fund fees and expenses resulting from the Fund's investment of cash received from securities lending borrowers

are not included in Total Annual Fund Operating Expenses and therefore, the above waivers do not apply to such investments.

(13)Victory Core Plus Intermediate Bond Fund - Class R6 Shares: The management fee is comprised of a base fee (which is equal to an annualized rate of 0.50% of the first \$50 million of average daily net assets, 0.40% of that portion of average daily net assets over \$50 million but not over \$100 million, and 0.30% of that portion of average daily net assets in excess of \$100 million) and a performance adjustment. (the "Adviser") has contractually agreed to waive its management fee and/or reimburse expenses so that the total annual fund operating expenses (excluding certain items such as performance fee adjustments, acquired fund fees and expenses, if any, interest, taxes, brokerage commissions, capitalized expenses, and other extraordinary expenses) do not exceed an annual rate of 0.39% of the Class R6, through at least August 31, 2026. The Adviser is permitted to recoup management fees waived and expenses reimbursed for up to three years after the date of the waiver or reimbursement, subject to the lesser of any operating expense limits in effect at the time of: (a) the original waiver or expense reimbursement; or (b) the recoupment, after giving effect to the recoupment amount. The amount of any waivers or reimbursements and the amount of any recoupment is calculated without regard to the impact of any performance adjustment to the Fund's management fee. This agreement may only be terminated by the Fund's Board of Trustees.

(15)Cohen & Steers Realty Shares, Inc. - Class Z: Cohen & Steers Capital Management, Inc., the Fund's investment advisor (the "Advisor"), has contractually agreed to waive its fee and/or reimburse expenses through June 30, 2026, so that the Fund's total annual operating expenses (excluding acquired fund fees and expenses, taxes and extraordinary expenses) do not exceed 0.80% for Class Z shares. This contractual agreement can only be amended or terminated by agreement of the Fund's Board of Directors and the Advisor and will terminate automatically in the event of termination of the investment advisory agreement between the Advisor and the Fund.
